I. Amendments to minutes from SMU meeting

III. Time Standards

- A. Common language and format for meet information for Senior Circuit Champs along with procedure for e-mail entries were discussed.

IV. 2004 Sectional Meet Bids

- A. Short course (TAMU) and Long course (GCAT) sectional bids were Okayed by USA swimming.
- B. Discussed possibility for Short course sectionals of running prelim short course and finals long course.
- C. Still the possibility for the qualifying for Olympic Trials short course; this will be decided at convention in September; our meet will go accordingly.

V. 2003 GCAT LC Sectionals

- A. It was recommended to rent a 6-lane 25-yard city pool across the street from GCAT pool with three school busses on a rotation basis to shuttle athletes to pool.
- B. Thursday warm-up and warm-down GCAT pool only; Friday, Saturday and Sunday utilizing city pool for warm-up during the meet.
- C. Recommend that finals warm-up be limited to finals only.
- D. The two 25 yard lanes at the end of the GCAT pool are to be used for warm-down only.

VI. Grand Prix Meet LC 2004

- A. Prize money etc. will be up to the meet host; eligibility issues will be checked into.
- B. Okay to raise meet entry fee by \$1.00 per event or determine a splash fee per swimmer.

VII. New Business

A. Long Course meet #3 recommend rule changes

1. At meet managements discretion if meet is at least 500 swimmers, an A and B prelims format could be implemented based on precedent information from like type meets i.e. Janet Evans Invitational and Charlotte UltraSwim Invitational.
2. To swim the 400 IM and the 400 Free must at least have the A cut as in the 800 and 1500 Free.
