- I. Amendments to minutes from A&M meeting

 - A. Senior Champs will be bid at sectionals.
 - B. Senior Circuit Champs to be held 6/17 – 6/20. A provisional bid was submitted by University of Texas. This will be revisited at the TSA meeting.
 - C. Senior Circuit #2 dates are 6/4 – 6/6 awarded to Dallas Mustangs to be held at SMU.
 - D. Grand Prix meet will be 5/21 – 5/23 to be held at A&M.

- E. Senior Circuit #1 will be 5/1 – 5/2 to be held at two sites with the North meet awarded to GCAT to be held at Carroll ISD pool and the South meet awarded to TWST.
